Theme:	Think
Ages in History (different decades/eras e.g. 60s, 70s, 80's, 90's) -	French Revolution, WW1,WW2, exploration and Discovery, James Cook, Christopher Columbus, early settlers, European explorers, technology, modernisation, retro.
Weather the Storm -	Weather, seasons, surviving the extremes, natural disasters, fires, drought, earthquakes, landslides, shipwrecks, volcanoes, Antarctica, deserts, Titanic, Twin Towers, Pompeii, Mt Erebus, MH370, White Island, Tangiwai train wreck.
Ignite light & Action -	Speed, sport, movement, rhythm, light, circus, Broadway, Olympics, theatre.

-Important Information-

Everyone has been grouped into the following categories for a compulsory large group performance:

- o Motueka all years 7-13 students
- \circ Nelson all years 7-13 students
- o Nelson site all years 3-6 Junior students
- West Coast students
- o Blenheim students

Requirements/rules for large group performances:

- o Performances MUST be no longer than 15 minutes.
- They MUST include some form of music singing, choir, piano, quitar, backing track.
- You must include an introduction explaining what your performance involves and how it links to your chosen theme.
- Everyone in your group must be involved in your performance in some way.
- Please ensure you keep your expenses below \$100 (this will not be reimbursed)

Small Group Performances (optional)

This could include:

- o Bands
- o Singing Groups (trio, duet, quartet, solo, small choirs).
- Small skits (preferably few/no props please)
- o Other performances

Requirements/rules for small group performances:

- You must include an introduction explaining what your performance involves and how it links to your chosen theme.
- o Your performance MUST be no longer than 15 minutes.
- Please ensure that you keep your expenses under \$50 (this will not be reimbursed)
- -Due to the current economic pressure it is not a requirement to dress-up for your performance or include props-

Everyone MUST participate in at least one performance.

There will be a submission form coming out soon for you to fill in what performance you will be doing on the day, as these need to get approved by the CA's so you can start practicing your performances.

There is going to be a set entry fee for students and community members attending that will also cover the cost of your lunch - Amount is yet to be confirmed.
