THEMES

There are the three themes running throughout the day.

Activities and musical performances must come under the following categories



There will be two parts to the day.

1. Winging It (Activities)

Activities include:

- Photo competition
 - Cake competition
- Upper South Airlines safety-briefing film festival
 - **Art competition** (we have added this section in for those of you who are art lovers, the themes are the same as all the activities.

All activities must fall under the categories shown on page 2.

Photographs and cakes to be made beforehand, to be displayed and judged on the day. Safety-briefing films will be approved, produced and judged prior the day. All film submissions must be sent to brynlee.beatson19@nz.oneschoolglobal.com by 10th June in order to be judged. The top three will be shown on the day.

2. Reach For The Stars (Music/Drama performances)

Each group/soloist has to demonstrate one of the themes - Aviation / Be a Star / Space & Future, through a song and/or drama performance.

Each song / act has to have a 1 minute introduction explaining why they chose that category and the reason and thought behind the performance.

For those of you who are thinking about bands and what songs you would like to use, all song choices and performance scripts must be emailed to the following student leaders:

Please note* All drama/music performances must **NOT** be more than 15mins long otherwise your act will be disqualified.



Below are the rubrics which will be used to judge all performances and competitions:

Music/Drama Performances will be judged on the following criteria:

Creativity of the play, script and acting. (focus is on the performance rather than the props)

Originality of the performance - show us something we haven't seen before.

Relevance to the chosen theme.

Crowd Favourite: crowd response - get the crowd excited about your performance.

Please note* Your performance must not be more than 15mins long. Time penalties will come into play. No performances can be practiced during school hours until after Queens Birthday weekend (3rd of June).

Art Competition will be judged on the following criteria:

Creativity: How creative is the art piece?

Relevance: Is it relevant to the chosen theme?

Originality: How original is the art piece

Cake Competition will be judged using the following criteria:

Creativity: How creative is the cake, is it a new idea, is it something that hasn't been done before?

Execution: How well is the cake constructed?

Relevance: Is it relevant to the chosen theme?

Photo Competition will be judged using the following criteria:

Creativity: Have you seen a photo like this before, is it original? Take a photo of something different and unseen.

Quality of the photo: The photo must be of a high resolution so the judges can see it clearly.

Relevance: Is it relevant to the theme and categories chosen? The photos will come under a theme (the three themes running throughout the day) as well as one of the following categories

- Edited (filter or Photoshop)
- Unedited (no filter or editing)

Safety Briefing Video will be judged on the following criteria:

Creativity: How different is the video, has it been seen before like on an Air New Zealand safety video? Make it different and creative.

Cinematography: The quality of the editing

Relevance: Is it relevant to the chosen theme?

Under the time limit: 5mins

Think outside of the box – e.g. create a song remix, original and unusual performances, play around with exotic cake ideas... does it really have to be round or square??... put a twist on it.

Explore the themes -

Be a Star - Always doing your best, aiming high, the bright happy person/thing, achieving your goals(target board).










